### WHY IS SATAN PROMOTING THE NAME OF JESUS?

## IS HE PREPARING THE WORLD FOR THE FALSE JESUS (ANTICHRIST)?

2 Thessalonians 2:8-12 (KJV) And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: *Even him*, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

The first question you may ask as you read the title above is why I would proffer those two questions as a title and subtitle.

Well, allow me to get straight to the point of this writing: I have noticed that beginning in 2021 and forward a pronounced effort by non-Christian forces to promote the name of Jesus. The four promotions I wish to analyze are as follows:

- The Chosen Series
- He Gets Us Commercials even on the Super Bowl costing an estimated 100 million dollars.
- The Asbury Revival
- The "Jesus Revolution" movie.

Please read this excerpt as we prepare to review above promotions:

### The "Jesus" the World Loves – The Berean Call

Excerpt: The world, which rarely looks to the Bible for information about Jesus, is satisfied with any other source, as long as their Jesus is devoid of judgmentalism, exclusiveness, negativity, and can be reflected in every one's belief system. Many "like" Jesus, including some atheists who speak highly of the character of their Jesus. Hindu gurus who flooded the West during the 1980s wrote books describing their avatar "Jesus." Islamic clerics praise Jesus (Isa in Arabic) although they deny that he is the Son of God (i.e., Allah, who has no son).

All of that is expected of the world. Yet in our day when much of the church is heavily influenced by the world, the "Jesus" the world loves is often reflected in the beliefs of professing Christians as well as some of those who may be born again. A false Jesus who manifests characteristics that appeal to the fleshly nature of Christians is a powerfully seductive device of Satan, who is "the god of this world" (2 Corinthians:4:3-4).

Those who profess to be Christians quite often have ideas about Jesus that are just as wrong as those people who don't claim to be Christians. For example, Jehovah's Witnesses believe that Jesus is a created god and that He is also Michael the Archangel. Mormons believe Jesus is the spirit brother of Lucifer and that He was married and had children. The followers of Christian Science and the Religious Science religions believe that Jesus was simply a man upon whom the "Christ empowerment" came. Roman Catholics believe that the bread and wine of the Eucharist can be transubstantiated, or changed, into the literal body and blood of Jesus, who is then ingested into one's stomach. Lutherans believe that Jesus is consubstantiated, or present, "in, with, and under" the bread and wine of communion. Such unbiblical beliefs are a mere handful among hundreds promoted by various Christian denominations and cults. Yet what is even more appalling is that an inquiry about Jesus today among those who call themselves evangelicals (Bible-believing Christians!) too often reveals "another Jesus" and a "false Christ." How does that happen?

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Most of the following in this document will be a collection of resources that I have had access to as I have researched the above promotions.

But before I provide those resources, I wish to share with you what my proposed answer is to those questions above. I strongly suspect that Satan is preparing the world for the appearance of a false Jesus.

I would remind you from my past writing that I received information from David Spangler, an occultist of high ranking, representing the Lucis Trust in New York city and the Findhorn Foundation of the United Nations who made this statement: They will introduce their king coming in the heavens with holographic imagery, and that it will be viewed by all people throughout the earth. He also said that they would explain the disappearance of Christians as those who were not ready for the Age of Aquarius. He indicated that they already in the late 1990's had scripted what was going to be given to the major News Media to explain that disappearance. Remember Satan can read the Scriptures and he is expecting God's prophetical promises and warnings to be fulfilled – but only God knows when.

Right down the ages, in many world cycles and in many countries (and today in all) great points of tension have occurred which have been characterised by a hopeful sense of expectancy. Someone is expected and His coming is anticipated. Always in the past, it has been the religious teachers of the period who have fostered and proclaimed this expectancy and the time has always been one of chaos and difficulty, of a climaxing point at the close of a civilisation or culture and when the resources of the old religions have seemed inadequate to meet men's difficulties or to solve their problems. The coming of the Avatar, the advent of a Coming One and, in terms of

today, the reappearance of the Christ are the keynotes of the prevalent expectancy. When the times are ripe, the invocation of the masses is strident enough and the faith of those who know is keen enough, then always He has come and today will be no exception to this ancient rule or to this universal law. For decades, the reappearance of the Christ, the Avatar, has been anticipated by the faithful in both hemispheres—not only by the Christian faithful, but by those who look for Maitreya and for the Boddhisattva as well as those who expect the Imam Mahdi.

When men feel that they have exhausted all their own resources and have come to an end of all their own innate possibilities and that the problems and conditions confronting them are beyond their solving or handling, they are apt to look for a divine Intermediary and for the Mediator Who will plead their cause with God and bring about a rescue. They look for a Saviour. This doctrine of Mediators, of Messiahs, of Christs and of Avatars can be found running like a golden thread through all the world faiths and Scriptures and, relating these world Scriptures to some central source of emanation, they are found in rich abundance everywhere. Even the human soul is regarded as an intermediary between man and God; Christ is believed by countless millions to act as the divine mediator between humanity and divinity.

I also wish to remind you that all four movements listed above are ecumenical, which means the Vatican (Satan's current seat) is in approval of these promotions. 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### The Chosen Series – A Critique

NEW BOOKLET – Lighthouse Trails: **THE CHOSEN Series—10 Critical Concerns** 

**Excerpt: Concern #1:** 

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? (2 Corinthians 6:14)

The Chosen series was initiated and inspired from a partnership between Dallas Jenkins, an evangelical filmmaker, and three Mormon businessmen, Jeffrey and Neal Harmon and Derral Eves after the three men viewed a film written and directed by Jenkins called *The Shepherd*. The Mormon influence on *The Chosen* is considerable: the executive producer is Mormon, the distributor is Mormon, certain episodes were shot on a special Mormon set in Utah, and the crowdfunding and media expertise is provided by Mormons.

In 2017, Dallas Jenkins had reached a self-described career low as a filmmaker when he was given an opportunity to partner with the successful Mormon businessmen who believed they could create a "global phenomenon"1 with *The Chosen*. With the Mormon church's long-standing hope and efforts to be viewed by the evangelical church as just another denomination and Jenkin's unsatisfied desire to be a successful Christian filmmaker, it seemed like the perfect match to help each other out. Thus, the birth of The Chosen.2

Those who defend *The Chosen* may say that so far (through Season 2), no Mormon doctrine has been introduced into the series, and therefore, it's not a problem that Mormons and evangelicals are working together. If this were a secular film, perhaps that would be a valid argument. But in a film series that is supposed to be depicting the life and ministry of Jesus Christ and His disciples and which claims to complement the Bible's message, then 2 Corinthians 6:14 must be applied where believers (who are to be in the light) are instructed not to be unequally yoked with those who are in spiritual darkness.

It is ironic that forty years ago, Christians were flocking to their churches by the tens of thousands to watch a film called *The God Makers*, which warned about Mormonism, most particularly about the false Jesus of Mormonism. Today, in stark contrast, countless Christians are enthusiastically watching a film about Jesus that is Mormon-influenced with seemingly little concern or spiritual discernment.

- 6. The campaign's stated goal is about inspiration, not a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 7. The next steps offered by He Gets Us could lead someone far away from truth rather than toward it.

Following the money and backers leads to organizations such as Servant Christian Foundation  $\frac{\#1}{2}$ , whose donors remain anonymous. However, this organization's website is linked to The Church of the Servant  $\frac{\#2}{2}$  and The Seattle School of Theology & Psychology #3.

Marketing firm Haven conceptualized and crafted the non-denomination campaign, and popular ministry partner Gloo, which uses data to help Churches grow and develop receivables, supported the campaign, ensuring partners have the ability to respond to all upcoming inquiries. #4

They promote another "Jesus" focusing on how Jesus was "a marginalized immigrant refugee who was bullied for his empathy." They aim to bring a "Jesus" that is tolerant of all human behavior. Here is a quote from their site:

Have you ever experienced frustration? Sorrow? Temptation? So has Jesus. Jesus understood what life was like for people in his day — especially for the marginalized. He was drawn to those on the fringes because he was one too: An immigrant. Homeless. Arrested. Bullied. Through it all, Jesus welcomed outcasts, stood up for women, hung out with troublemakers, even befriended enemies. He did it because of his radical love, empathy, and acceptance for all of us. They try to categorize Jesus as some kind of social "activist." Jesus invited all to participate in the love, but not everyone was interested. The powerful and the wealthy were often threatened by Jesus' movement because it always resisted systems of oppression. After all, many benefited from oppressing the poor, the sick, women, and even certain races that Jesus embraced throughout his activism. So, they didn't just reject his invitation; they killed him for it. #5

<u>Asbury Revival: The Ecumenical School of Mysticism</u> - Phoenix Rising:Birthing the Strong Delusion

Asbury Theological Seminary has a painted labyrinth. Labyrinths are spiritual portals that ancient pagans used to enter the spiritual realm.

Asbury Seminary invites you to Awaken spiritually through meditation.

They also have rooms with great acoustics, which are perfect for repetitive chanting during Lectio Divina prayer.

This is a Liberal "Christian" College.

### **Complete Article:**

People are divided over the Asbury revival. This is partially due to their definition of revival. Orthodox Christians may use a Scriptural definition from Second Kings 22 through 23, which states that King Josiah sent Shaphan to the house of God to count the offerings, so they could repair the temple. Shaphan found the Book of Gods' Law in the temple and he read it to the king (2 Kings 22, KJV). The King repented of his sins and he read the Book to the people. The people repented of their sins and returned to the written Word of God. They removed the pagan idols

from God's house. Then, they drove out the apostate priests and those who followed heretical teachings (2 Kings 23, KJV). In this pattern of revival, the people heard and returned to the law of God. Then they repented for their sins and removed the idols and apostate priests from the house of God.

However, Charismatics define revival as a special visitation of the Holy Spirit that draws people to one place of worship. They say it is a season of unusual visitation of God. They define this experience variously as; a sweet presence, a tangible wave of the Spirit, or the fire of God. Charismatics often travel great distances to experience the "fire of God," or anointing of God because they believe they can carry it back to their church and release or activate spiritual gifts. They are always looking to ride the next wave of the Spirit. This pattern is experience-driven. There is a move away from reading the Scripture.

Let us consider the Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore Kentucky. Asbury "was founded in 1923" with an emphasis on ecumenicalism. They work in unity with 93 denominations around the world. This fusion includes United Methodists, African Methodist Episcopal, and Wesleyans.[i] Wesleyan tradition is engrained in the philosophy of Friend's University, which incorporates "50 denominational traditions."[ii] In keeping with Friend's University Asbury Seminary states that they combine "an academics degree that is coupled with deeply rooted spiritual formation practices."[iii] In spiritual formation, the practitioner focuses on the Holy Spirit to guide them toward a "union with God." This university calls this Christian Mysticism. These spiritual practices include prayer walking on a labyrinth, "contemplative prayer, and Lectio Divina – the tradition of monastic practice of scriptural reading...."[iv]

Richard Foster of Friends University explains spiritual formation (contemplative prayer). [v] He warns that contemplative prayer (meditation) is not safe for novices. Mr. Foster does not issue such a warning about other forms of mediation. He explains that through silent contemplation, one may travel deep within the spiritual realm, where they meet forces that are not divine. He says many spiritual beings do not serve God. Therefore, he advises you to pray for protection before engaging in contemplative prayer. [vi] Yet, the Bible does not warn us to invoke protection before praying to the Father. Nor does it tell us to engage in spiritual practices that open doors to these unclean spirits.

Today, spiritual formation is spreading rapidly throughout colleges and seminaries. Richard Foster says the purpose of these meditation exercises is to create an inner sanctuary. [vii] Proponents believe that through contemplation, one may "find God within." [viii] Mr. Foster's meditation techniques include visualization, [ix] which is tantric Buddhism. In visualization, one creates thinking pictures. [x] Alice Bailey, the mother of the New Age Movement, says the secret to meditation is the ability to visualize. She says visualization is the first principle of the occult law, which states that "energy follows thought." [xi]

Richard Foster also promotes Lectio Divina. In this meditation method, one repeats portions of Scripture like a mantra. [xii] This produces an altered state of consciousness. It does not matter what the words are it is the pause between them that produces a trance. This is called getting in the gap. Therefore, Asbury Theological Seminary is teaching Eastern mysticism and Western esotericism (New Age and occult practices) to their students.

Currently, many are concerned that the New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) may use the Asbury revival to spawn another event like the "Toronto Blessing." [xiii] Even worse, they could fan the flames of a national movement that would spread a counterfeit revival marked by mysticism, which is the key to merging all world religions to form one universal (apostate) church.

On February 23, 2023, the Collegiate Day of Prayer simulcast was hosted by Asbury Theological Seminary. This followed a two-week-long revival at Asbury. During the revival, The Collegiate Day of Prayer website hosted a campaign to adopt college campuses. This page states, "We want to see this generation raised up in revival and awakening." [xiv] Keep in mind that Asbury Seminary and other colleges that started revivals in response to Asbury appear on Lighthouse Trail's "Spiritual Formation" (contemplative prayer) list. The authors of Lighthouse Trails voice their concern that students from these universities are being converted by these esoteric practices and beliefs. Meditation opens practitioners to seducing spirits, which leads them to Eastern mysticism. [xv]

Moreover, the Collegiate Day of Prayer: 40-Day Prayer Guide, lists many members of the New Apostolic Reformation as contributing authors including Lou Engle. [xvi] Other members of the NAR that connect with this event include worship leaders from the International House of Prayer (IHOP). [xvii] Also, Allen Hood, M.Div. from Asbury Seminary serves as the Associate Director of IHOP. [xviii] Francis Chan publicly endorses the NAR. [xix] Also, Andy Roman says, Rick Warren of the Emergent Church Movement went to Asbury Seminary "to spread the revival to 20 million students on 4,300 college campuses." [xx] Before his retirement, Rick Warren promoted hard ecumenicalism, as he combined Catholicism, Islam, and evangelical traditions. [xxi] It is clear that all religions are merging and this includes mystical tradition, which Revelation 17 calls Mystery Babylon.

In conclusion, the Bible does not say that a Godly revival will sweep the earth before the return of Christ. Instead, Mathew 24:24 says, "For there shall arise false Christs and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect" (KJV). The Bible says Jesus will not return until after the falling away from the truth. Second Thessalonians says:

"Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. Do you not remember that when I was still with you, I told you these things? And now you know what is restraining, that he may be revealed in his own time. For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way. And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this reason, God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness" (2:3-12)."

Granted, a new convert does not always change everything overnight. However, there are certain practices that should change relatively quickly. The converted hippies continued in their hippie lifestyle, still experimenting in drugs and sexual escapades. Their appearance identified themselves more with the unconverted hippie movement than with a new life and "new creature" values.

This, perhaps, can be most easily seen in their leader, a man named Lonnie Frisbee, who is featured in the "Jesus Revolution" book and movie. Lonnie Frisbee's claim of salvation is rooted in a time when he was 17 years old. While on an acid trip in a California wilderness, he stripped naked and called out, "Jesus, if you're really real, reveal yourself to me." He claims to have then seen a vision where hundreds of young people were being baptized in the waters off the coast of California. This sketchy salvation testimony led him to change his appearance to make himself look like an Old Testament prophet, or Jesus (the Hippie Jesus look so prevalent of his day). Frisbee became the defacto leader of the Jesus People movement.

Frisbee was instrumental in the various Jesus People ministries, and even helped start churches. But he was also involved in a homosexual lifestyle and continued to experiment with drugs. That is not the kind of Church leader that should be elevated as an example, as the Jesus Movement does. Frisbee eventually contracted HIV and died from AIDS in 1993.

The Jesus Movement was built on a theologically weak foundation, with a theologically weak man (if he was even truly converted) as its leader. Yet, it has been called a Holy Spirit Revival amongst young people in that day. The movement also produced theologically problematic fruit. The Jesus Movement was a major contributor to the modern Charismatic movement, as well as the modern Contemporary Christian Music movement. The trifecta of emotionalism, charismaticism, and cultural accommodation have been the key ingredients that have made the modern Contemporary Worship scene what it is today.





One of my greatest heartaches in my last 45+ years of research has been the blindness and the naiveite of many Christians regarding the battle for the truth of Scripture in this age of apostasy. Albert Barnes notes this regarding the wiles of the devil in Eph. 6:11:

Against the wiles of the devil. The word rendered "wiles" meqodeia means, properly, that which is traced out with method; that which is methodized; and then that which is well laid--art, skill, cunning. It occurs in the New Testament only in <a href="Eph 4:14">Eph 4:14</a>, and in this place. It is appropriately here rendered wiles, meaning cunning devices, arts, attempts to

delude and destroy us. The wiles of the devil are the various arts and stratagems which he employs to drag souls down to perdition. We can more easily encounter open force than we can cunning; and we need the weapons of Christian armour to meet the attempts to draw us into a snare, as much as to meet open force. The idea here is, that Satan does not carry on an open warfare. He does not meet the Christian soldier face to face. He advances covertly; makes his approaches in darkness; employs cunning rather than power, and seeks rather to deceive and betray than to vanguish by mere force. Hence the necessity of being constantly armed to meet him whenever the attack is made. A man who has to contend with a visible enemy may feel safe, if he only prepares to meet him in the open field. But far different is the case if the enemy is invisible; if he steals upon us slyly and stealthily; if he practices war only by ambushes and by surprises. Such is the foe that we have to contend with--and almost all the Christian struggle is a warfare against stratagems and wiles. Satan does not openly appear. He approaches us not in repulsive forms, but comes to recommend some plausible doctrine, to lay before us some temptation that shall not immediately repel us. He presents the world in an alluring aspect; invites to pleasures that seem to be harmless; and leads us in indulgence, until we have gone so far that we cannot retreat.

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I strongly encourage you to enlist in active-duty status as a soldier of Christ, placing all your trust in Him as we live in these apostate times.

Soldiers of Christ, arise,
And put your armor on,
Strong in the strength which God supplies
